Responsibilities involve:

1. Welcoming and introducing speaker;
2. Keeping track of the time to assure proper time management amongst speakers and to allow time for attendee questions and answers;
3. Thanking the speaker and attendees.

We will have an AV technician available to assist in case there are technical issues during the session.
